

- Bath Date: The trip will start on the first date and end on the last date from the batch dates.
- Pickup and Drop location: Bagdogra Airport IXB
- Distance: Bagdogra Airport to Phuentsholing: 4:00 hr (150.8 km) via road.
- Airport Pickup: Scheduled between 02:00 pm and 03:00 pm at Bagdogra Airport.
- Airport Drop: Scheduled at 01:00 pm. Kinldy book your flight after 3:00 PM onwards. If you have booked a late evening return flight, you have the option to wait at the airport.

Important Notice:

DAY 1: Bagdogra to Phuentsholing

Travel time: 4:00 to 5:00 hr (150.8 km)

- Upon your arrival at Bagdogra Airport, our representative will meet you, You'll start your journey from Bagdogra Airport reach Jiagaon our team member will guide you to cross the border into Bhutan via Pedestrian Terminal to reach Phuentsholing Town, The gateway to the land of thunder dragons, welcome to Bhutan.
- Upon arrival at the Phuentsholing hotel, we'll gather for a welcome dinner with a special cake and local wine.
- In the evening visit Zangtopelri on your own, this temple is located in the center of the Phuentsholing town.
- Cafes in Phuentsholing: Kizom Café and Mountain Café.
- Nightlife in Phuentsholing: If you'd like to experience the nightlife after dinner you can visit: Samsara Club and Lions Club.
- You'll stay overnight in Phuentsholing.







DAY 2: Phuentsholing to Thimphu

Travel time: 5 hr (145.6 km)

- After breakfast, ensure your luggage is ready,
- After immigration proceed towards Thimphu. The journey promises breathtaking scenery and memorable stops along the way.
- As you traverse the mountainous roads, make a stop at Gedu Stupa, stop for lunch and enjoy the drive through Bhutanese countryside moving forward witness Wangkha waterfalls.
- As you traverse the winding roads, make a stop at Chuzom, where the Paro and Thimphu rivers converge.
- In the evening, indulge in a captivating city walk around **Clock Tower, Thimphu city, on your own.**
- Nightlife in Thimphu: If one wishes to experience nightlife in Bhutan, Thimphu is the best place to be. This are few places to visit: Mojo Park. Space 34. where you can unwind with live music, dance, and mingle with fellow travelers and locals.
- You'll spend the **night in Thimphu**.







DAY 3: Thimphu to Punakha.

Travel time: 2.5 hours, 73.3 km - one way

Carry a bag pack for today, After breakfast start **Day excursion to Punakha**.

- **Dochula Pass:** This day involves a journey to Punakha En-route, Dochula Pass and its 108 chorten is located at an elevation of 3,988m.
- Chimi Lhakhang The Fertility Temple Stationed at the top of a hillock, the is a site dedicated to Lama Drukpa Kuenley. Known as the 'Divine Madman,
- **Punakha Dzong:** Also known as "the palace of great happiness" This Dzong is the most picturesque of all Bhutan ancient fortresses.
- **Suspension Bridge:** This hidden treasure in the Punakha Valley connects the rest of the valley to the old administrative center of Punakha Dzongkhag, perfect spot for photography.
- Optional Activity: River Rafting (Direct Pay Basis): The Mo Chhu river rafting is 10KM course which comprises of 10 rapids. The raft is 6-seater. River rafting time is approximately 1 hours.
- Optional Activity: Bike Ride (Direct Pay Basis): For adventure lovers, enjoy a self-ride (Himalayan Bike) experience on the Punakha day excursion from Thimphu. Ride through Bhutan's stunning landscapes and scenic mountain roads. Note: For experienced riders only.
- In the evening, you'll return to Thimphu for Stay.







Day 4: Thimphu Sightseeing

Travel time: 1:30 min, 50 km (Thimphu to Paro)

- Pack your luggage, have Breakfast, You'll spend the day exploring Thimphu's attractions today and move to **Paro for night stay.**
- **Buddha Dordenma:** The site is also known as Buddha Point.the Buddha Dordenma Statue stands as a testament to Bhutan's commitment to promoting peace and spiritual well-being.
- Takin Preservation Centre: You will find the National animal of Bhutan "Takin" in this open zoo. Takin is one of the most endangered species of the World and it is available only in Bhutan.
- **Simply Bhutan:** is a living museum that provides insight into traditional Bhutanese life and culture. Participate in cultural activities such as **archery and traditional dance,** taste local wine **Aara**.
- Jungshi Handmade Paper Factory: Here, visitors can witness the traditional Bhutanese paper-making process, which dates back centuries and is still practiced using age-old techniques.
- Durga Mata Temple: In the heart of Thimphu, the Durga Mandir, a sanctuary honoring Durga Mata the goddess of strength and protection.
 Built to celebrate her victory over darkness. It is the very first Hindu temple built in Thimphu.
- Rinpung Dzong night view: Highlight of the day, Just before entering Paro town Enjoy the enchanting night view of Rinpung Dzong! It's a sight you won't want to miss! Don't forget to capture this mesmerizing sight with Bhutanese attire in some beautiful photos.
- You'll stay overnight in Paro. (Dinner & Breakfast incl)







Day 5: Hike to Tiger's Nest

Hike time: Around 6 to 7 hrs, altitude: 3,120 m, 6.4 km

- Carry a **Bag pack for today**. This day will begin with an early breakfast. Embark on the iconic hike to **Tiger's Nest**.
- Taktsang Monastery The hike to Tiger's Nest is as much a spiritual pilgrimage as it is a physical challenge. The trail winds through dense pine forests and rhododendron trees, offering breathtaking views of the surrounding mountains and valleys.
- Traditional Hot Stone Bath (Direct Pay Basis): It is very nice
 to experience Bhutanese hot stone baths. It is the perfect
 way to relax and wind down after a hike, it is considered for
 numerous health benefits help relieve deepset aches and
 pains. When placed in water, the hot stones crack and
 steam, releasing key minerals that help to aid stress and
 soothe the body.
- You can choose to explore Paro market or simply relax at your hotel.
- Your overnight stay will be in Paro. (Dinner & Breakfast incl)








Day 6: Paro to Phuentsholing

Travel Time: 5 hours, 142 km

- We will begin our journey today after breakfast, allowing you some time to rest and recover from the previous day's hike.
- Our first stop will be at the Paro Airport Viewpoint, where you'll
 enjoy a breathtaking panoramic view of the airport set amidst the
 stunning valley landscape.
- Next, we'll visit the iconic Iron Bridge (Tamchog Zam)—a
 beautiful historic bridge offering a perfect backdrop for memorable
 photographs.
- We will also take a relaxing break at the **Issuna peaceful riverside** spot ideal for soaking in Bhutan's natural beauty.
- By evening, we'll arrive in Phuentsholing, where you'll have some free time to shop for local handicrafts and souvenirs—perfect keepsakes from your Bhutanese adventure.
- Please note that we don't have Chelela Pass in our itinerary, as the journey from Paro to Chelela Pass and then to Phuentsholing would be around 8 hours in total. Given the long travel time. we want to keep the day more relaxed while still covering meaningful experiences. Also, you will already have visited Dochula Pass, one of Bhutan's most iconic and scenic routes.
- Tonight's stay will be in **Phuentsholing** (Dinner & Breakfast included).







Day 7: Phuentsholing to Bagdogra Airport drop Travel time: 5:00 hr (150.8 km)

- On the final day of your journey in Bhutan, the day begins with a leisurely breakfast at your hotel in Phuentsholing. After enjoying your meal, it's time to check out and bid farewell to the warm hospitality that has accompanied you throughout your stay.
- Your driver will be waiting to transfer you to **Bagdogra Airport**, where you'll catch your departing flight. As you embark on this final leg of your trip, take a moment to reflect on the memories you've made, the sights you've seen, and the experiences you've cherished during your time in the **Land of the Thunder Dragon**.

- Bring your original Voter Card or a valid Indian passport. (Passport with six months of validity from the last day of your Bhutan trip)
- For Children (Under 18): Passport or Birth Certificate.
- (Details Should be written in English not in regional language)
- Notice: Aadhaar Card is not accepted for adults or children.
- If using a Voter ID, it must be the original issued by a government office, not a PVC card printed from an online download.
- No passport-size photocopies or any copies of your Voter ID or passport are required; only the original documents need to be carried.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. We're a couple, do we need to share a room?

 No, you do not need to share a room. Couples can opt for double sharing without sharing with other travelers.

2. I'm traveling Solo, how will I be accommodated?

• For solo travelers, accommodation will be arranged on a twin sharing basis with same-gender.

3. What currency is used in Bhutan?

• Bhutan's national currency is the Ngultrum (BTN). However, Indian currency is widely accepted everywhere. so there's no need to exchange INR for Bhutanese Ngultrum.

4. Are ATMs / Credit Card available in Bhutan?

 While there are ATMs in Bhutan. It's advisable to carry sufficient cash to ensure smooth transactions during your trip. Credit card is still not common in Bhutan. Very few stores/hotels accept VISA card with 5% charges.

5. Is Bhutan safe for solo traveling?

• Yes, Bhutan is considered one of the safest destinations for solo travelers. It offers a welcoming and secure environment. However joining a group can help reduce these costs.

6. Are there any restrictions on dress?

 There are no rules about what visitors should wear. However for visiting places like religious sites, respectful clothing that covers your body from shoulders to knees is appropriate and appreciated.

7. How much cash can I bring into Bhutan?

• You may bring cash equivalent to US\$10,000 into the country.

8. What is the weather like in Bhutan and when is the best time to visit?

Bhutan is a year-round destination. There are four seasons: summer (June to August), autumn (September to November), winter (December to February) and spring (March to May). But because of the range of altitudes in the country, and the influence of the north Indian monsoons, the climate is incredibly varied.

9. Additional Expenses Overview.

To assist with your trip planning, here's an estimate of additional expenses:

- Lunch: Approximately Rs. 300.00 to Rs. 500.00 pp per meal. Note: Prices may vary, especially for authentic Bhutanese meals.
- Entrance Fees for Monuments: Around Rs. 5000.00 pp in total for all sightseeing places.
- Punakha River Rafting: Approximately Rs. 2000.00 pp.
- Hot Stone Bath: Approximately Rs. 1500.00 to Rs. 2000.00 pp.
- Bike Rent: ₹2500.00 per day (only bike charges). Fuel will be provided full tank; needs to be refilled on return.

Please note that these amounts are approximate and may vary based on actual consumption and current rates. We recommend planning accordingly and feel free to contact us for any further details or questions you may have.



DOS AND DON'TS FOR YOUR TRIP TO BHUTAN

Dos:

- A prayer wheel contains a scroll of mantras at its core, called a "Life Tree." The wheel is always spin clockwise,
- Photography Guidelines: Always ask for permission first and only take photos after receiving it. Additionally, refrain from photographing police personnel and refrain from taking pictures inside temples and monasteries.
- Dress Code: When visiting religious sites, please wear appropriate attire. Men should wear long pants, while women should opt for long skirts or dresses that cover their shoulders.
- Waste Disposal: Please do not litter. The Bhutanese view their natural environment as a sacred gift, so it's important to respect it.
- Wildlife Guidlines: Don't disturb or feed wild animals.
- Zebra Crossings: Use zebra crossings when crossing roads; failure to do so may result in fines, Use pedestrian walkways when walking.

Don'ts:

- Respect cultural: Avoid touching or pointing feet at religious objects.
- **Don't Smoke in Public:** Smoking in the public areas is strictly prohibited and liable to be fined. Spitting on the wall and other places is discourage.
- Don't Disturb Wildlife: Keep a safe distance and avoid loud noises or sudden movements around animals.
- No Drones: Visitors can't fly drones. Approval only for government use.
- Avoid politically sensitive issues: It is wise to bear this in mind when conversing with local people. Avoid politically sensitive issues.
- Bargaining: Shops typically have fixed prices for all items, and bargaining is not common.
